

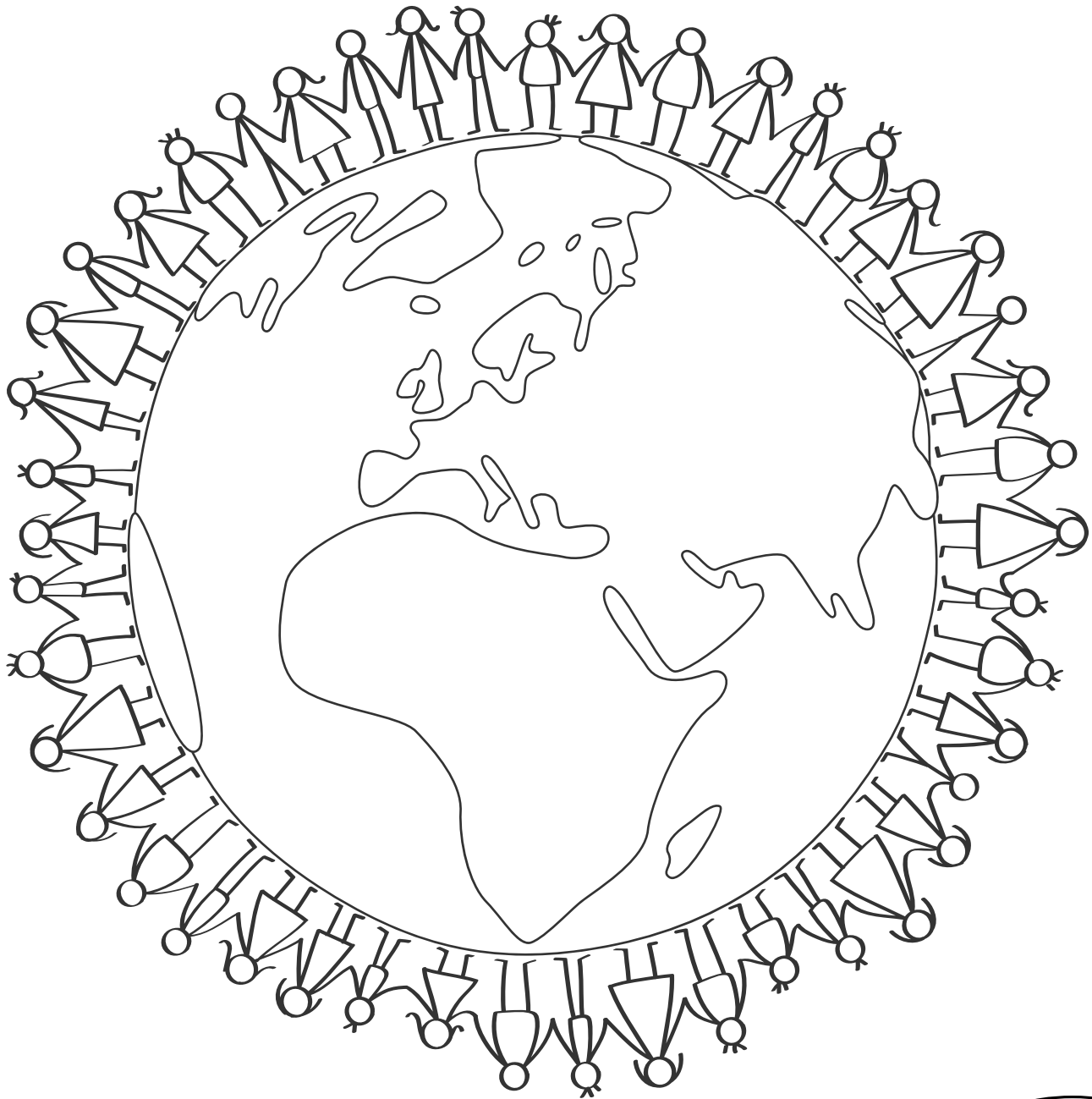



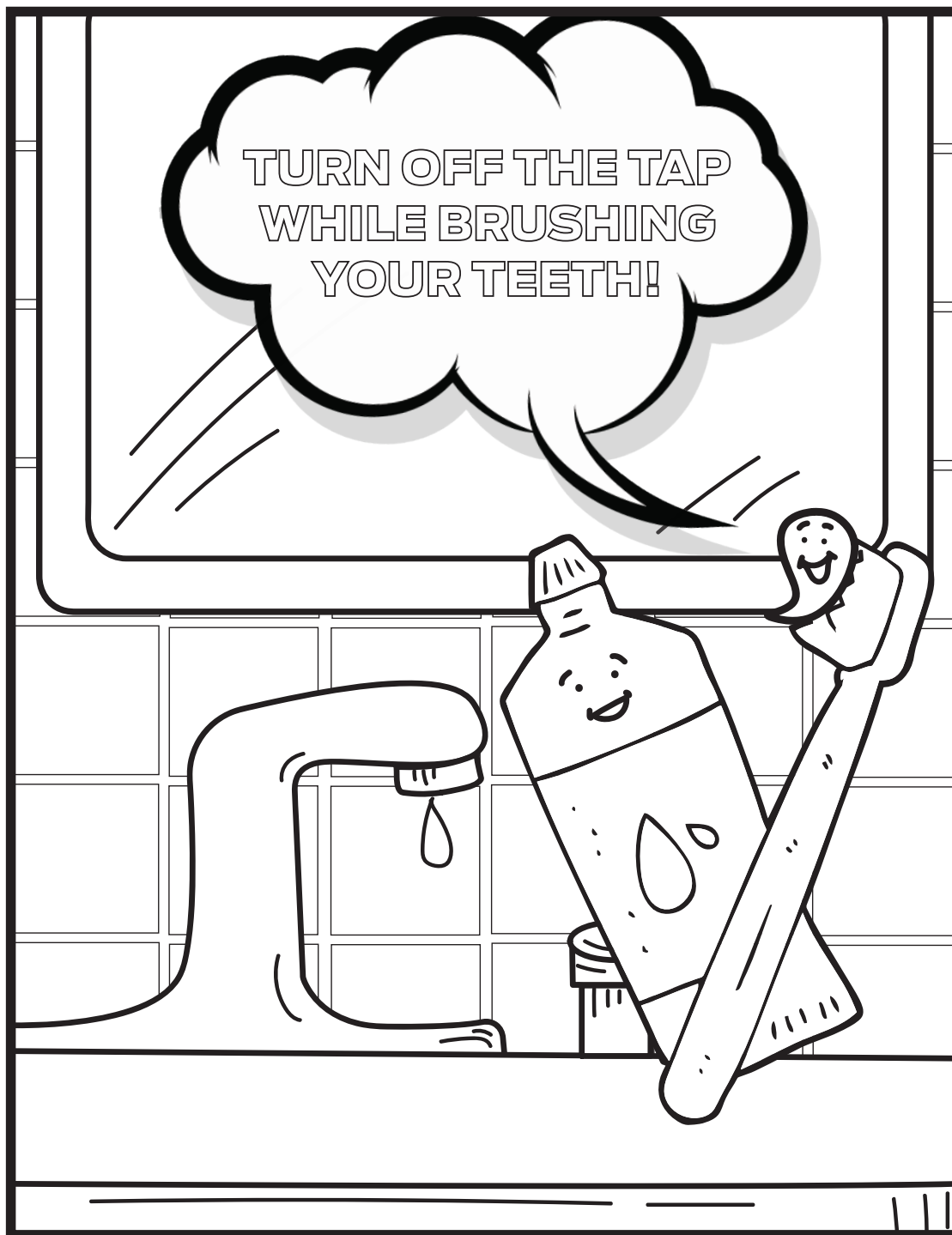


SAVING WATER AT HOME

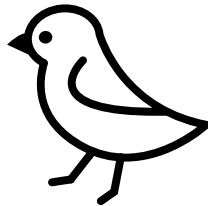
WHY EARTH DAY IS IMPORTANT


